Jerry Crawford played several short slide shows on a borrowed digital projector. The slide shows had been made with a program called *ProShow Gold*, using images taken with a digital camera, or scanned from conventional slides, negatives and photos. Somehow, the technology takes a picture that would strain to make a respectable 5" x 7" print, and makes it look terrific when blown up onto a 4' x 4' screen! The program can be used to burn the slide show onto a CD which can then be played in a DVD player onto a television screen. Music can be added, and zooming, motion, and transitional effects make it much more interesting than just a static slide show.
