Theme shoots for next year were selected and they are on the chart in this newsletter.

There were 7 entries in our Spring Photo Competition. Members were to select 4 photos they had taken this spring and mount them as one unit. It was interesting to see the variety of items that had been selected and to note that there was only 1 repeated item. It made for a very colourful display! Each member then judged all entries other than his own and results were tabulated. 1<sup>st</sup> was Anne McIntosh with her bird photos, 2<sup>nd</sup> Alie Neish with her flower photos, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Albert Orbin with a variety of images. The members were so pleased with these that they decided to do the same competition with summer photos. 4 photos are to be selected from the ones taken this summer and mounted as one unit. These will be judged at the Sept meeting.

Anne then presented Alie Neish with her gold medal for earning 500 club points.

Officers for next year were elected and these are on the newsletter header.

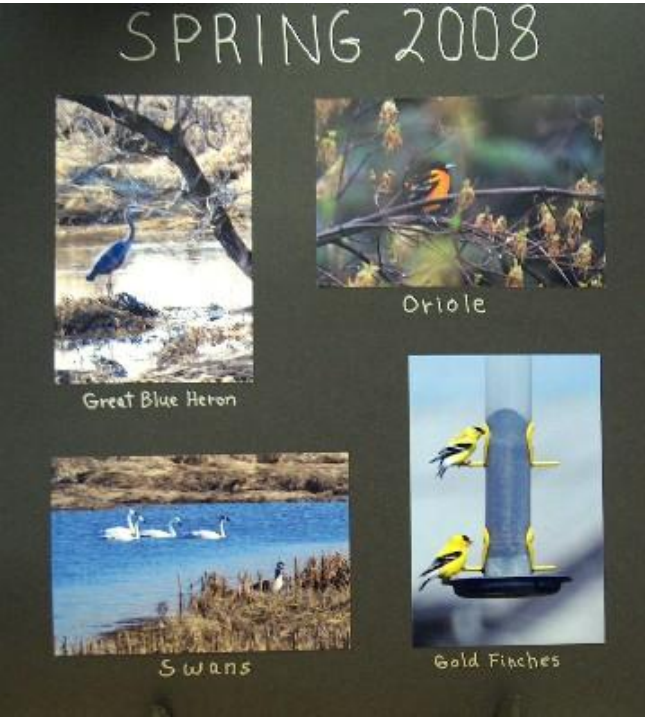
